EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

PEACE

Priest: The peace of the Lord be always with you,

All: **May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands
for the praise and glory of his name,
for our good and the good of all his holy Church.**

Priest: The Lord be with you

People: **and also with you.**

Priest: Lift up your hearts.

People: **We lift them to the Lord.**

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

God is praised for his mighty acts.

All: **Holy, holy, holy Lord,**

**God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

We retell the story of the Last Supper and offer praises to God.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

All: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name...

THE BREAKING OF BREAD

Priest: Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup,

All: we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

THE INVITATION

**All: Jesus is the Lamb of God
who takes away the sin of the world.
Blessed are those who are called to his supper.**

Priest Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,
but only say the word, and we shall be healed.

Leader: The Holy Trinity, in whose name we were baptized,
preserve us, members of Christ, children of God,
inheritors of the kingdom of heaven,

All: Glory to God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
